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## Online CEU Training Programs: The Basics

There are no scheduled classes to attend for online CEU training programs. Within the three (3) month access period, work independently at your own pace to complete the program and access your course information 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by logging into the AIHC website. A technical support professional is assigned to you to provide technology-related assistance throughout the program.

## Course Prerequisites

This course is designed to sharpen the skills of tactical to advanced coders and develop the skills of novice coders. The training addresses the more common and difficult coding chapters (see details below).

## Included in the Course Tuition

- A technical support professional is assigned to each professional enrolling in the program to provide professional guidance, technical website support, and assistance throughout the learning experience.

The OIG, under this Congressional mandate, established a program to exclude individuals and entities affected by these various legal authorities, contained in sections [1128](#) and [1156](#) of the [Social Security Act](#), and maintains a list of all currently excluded parties called the List of Excluded Individuals/Entities.
